



STUDENT INTAKE GUIDELINES 2016-2017

- Generally, children are admitted to their chronological age group and you apply for a school place in the year group that applies to your child.
- Once admitted, there may be some instances where the Principal may decide the child should be moved up or down a year group but this would only take place after consultation with you and any other professionals involved with your child.
- However, there may be some cases where applicants seek admission outside their chronological age group. In order to facilitate decisions on such applications, the school will require the parents to explain, with evidence, why they consider the child should be admitted out of normal chronological year at the time of admission.
- Most children begin Pre-school at the age of 3, Primary school at the age of 5 and Secondary school at the age of 11.
